

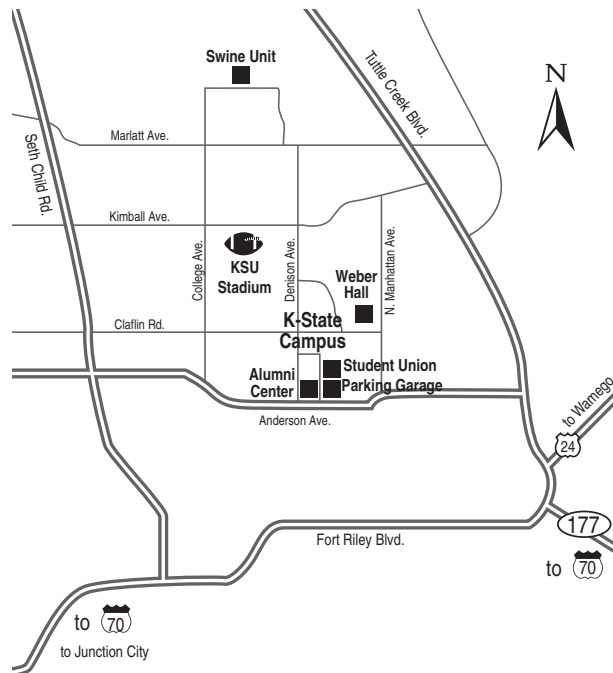
FEATURED SPEAKER

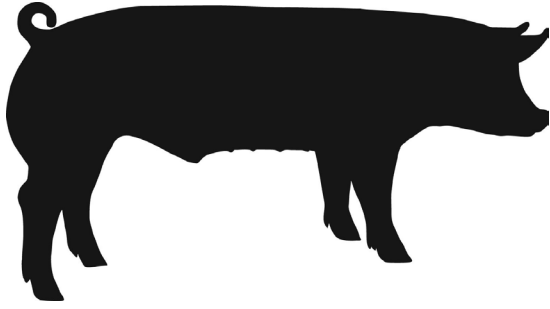
